



SUPER CYCLE CAR

Jim Musser wanted to design a street vehicle that would have race car handling and superbike performance. The result is the IndyCycle, a three-wheeler that combines IndyCar looks, sophisticated front suspension, and the push of a healthy sportbike. The kit comes almost completely assembled save for adding the motorcycle and extending the throttle cable, clutch hose, and shift linkage with components supplied in the kit. The \$3,995 kit also includes the fiberglass body, chassis, paddle shift linkage, master cylinders, pedal assembly, and cooling ducts with items such as turn signals, instrument cluster, and wiring harness reused from the donor bike.
